	(-) 17.	(-) 35.	This test is designed to be given to AAA School Safety Patrol members who have completed an instruction and training period in school safety patrol functions and methods of operation.
	(+) 18.	(+) 36.	The time required for the test will vary according to the age and grade level of the pupils.
	(-) 19.	(-) 37.	Approximately thirty minutes is sufficient time under ordinary conditions. It is self-administering and therefore requires little instruction from the teacher except the usual caution that students read and follow the directions carefully.
	(-) 20.	(-) 38.	To facilitate scoring, fold the key at the left on the solid vertical lines. Place the numbered answers for each page beside the corresponding numbers on the pupil's test sheets.
(+) 1.	(+) 21.	(+) 39.	It is not to be considered that all points in this test are of equal importance from the standpoint of safety. It is difficult to set up a rating scale which will be satisfactory in all cases. Some of the test statements may not relate to all activities. Many schools, for example, do not use buses. Test statements on this phase of operation would not pertain to the operation of many Safety Patrol members. The following rating scale is offered as a suggestions. Use it if it seems suited to the safety factors in your situation and to the age and understanding of your pupils.
